The Danish Genealogical Word List shows Danish words and their English translations for many words that are found in documents used to research Danish ancestors. If the word you are looking for is not on this list, please consult a Danish-English dictionary. (See the "Additional Resources" section below.) Danish is a Germanic language like Swedish, Norwegian, and Icelandic. A major spelling and grammar reform was introduced in Denmark in 1953. Most differences between modern and old Danish are simply a matter of spelling. The spelling section in "Language Characteristics" below, along with the English to Danish Word list are designed to help you find the words you need. Due to community feedback the Danish Word List is now available in a PDF format. This list was created by revising the Genealogical Word List for Denmark that is now out of print. Some words that did not seem relevant to Danish research were removed. Many words were added including many occupations. There are 1, 278 terms in this list. The PDF will be updated as the Word List is improved. LANGUAGE CHARACTERISTICS

Variant Forms of Words

In Danish, as in English, the forms of some words will vary according to how they are used in a sentence. Who—whose—whom or marry—marries—married are examples of words in English with variant forms. The endings of a word in a document may differ from those in this list, for example:

Mand= man

Kone= wife

Manden= the man

Konen= the wife

Mænd= men

Koner= wives

Mænderne= the men

This word list gives the standard form of each word.

Alphabetical Order

Written Danish has three additional letters: \mathcal{A} (æ), Ø (ø), and Å (å). These letters are filed after A–Z alphabetically. The letter Å (å) was officially introduced in 1953, so it never appears in older records. Prior to that time it was usually written as Aa (aa) and filed at the beginning of the alphabet. Danish dictionaries and indexes, this word list, and the Locality section of the Family History Library Catalog use the following alphabetical order:






To find and use specific types of Danish records, you will need to know some key words in Danish. This section gives key genealogical terms in English and the Danish words with the same or similar meanings.






WORTHY Mrs. Goodal kept a school in Leith. In 1750, she was a widow of about eighty years of age. A letter of that date exists in which the good widow rather bitterly complains of a loss that had befallen her. As is known to readers of his autobiography, John Livingston, of Ancrum, had prepared some notes, explicatory of the Bible. Of these notes Mrs. Goodal's brother had taken a transcript. Unhappily for herself, she lent it to a merchant about to start for Holland. This took place before 1728. The merchant was to get it printed there. This is the end of Mrs. Goodal's MS. The merchant's name was David Randall, or as it is given sometimes, Randy or Randie, a man of capacity and public spirit. (Wodrow speaks of Mr. Randie, of Edinburgh, several times. Letters, iii., 483, 491, Analecta, vol. iv.) His son is one of the subjects of this sketch. Mrs. Goodal was not a little angry both with the father and son for retaining this Livingston MS., and they seem to have been rather careless in the matter.


By 1728, when David Randall went to Holland, his son Thomas, born 1710, had all but finished his literary course. This he had taken in Edinburgh, where he graduated as M.A. on May 24, 1730. There is a long gap between the taking of his degree and his first settlement in Scotland. This gap is accounted for, partly, by his father's connection with Holland. In yet earlier days than this, that land had been a busy mart of commerce, and Scotland had been well to the front in her trade. The persecutions, too, had taken many across the seas.


The Scottish colony had several flourishing centres, at Amsterdam, Dordrecht, and Campvere, at one time the only



















































